'O' signed from all directions on the approach to Mundford roundabout to parking. From the North & West A17 & A47 to Kings Lynn. At roundabout A47/A10/A148/A149 take the A10 south; in 3+ mile (roundabout) take the A134 Thetford, in 17 mile after the Mundford roundabout, turn left on to A1065 Swaffham road then after 1/2 mile turn right onto minor road Lynford Road, follow 'O' signs. Course Notes and Safety Information:

Only the White and Yellow courses are suitable for pushchairs.

Apart from the White, Yellow & Oranges, all courses cross a public road, where traffic is generally light unless there is a military exercise. Please take care when crossing this road. The busy A134 runs along the South Western edge of the area. It is not a good route choice on any course and is strictly out of bounds.

Lynford has scenic lakes, rivers and streams, and there is deep open water near the start. All courses cross water via bridges. Parents are asked to ensure that children are aware of the need to take care. In particular, please be aware that the Yellow (EAL W/M10) and Orange (EAL W/M12) courses have sections next to open water. If necessary, parents may shadow for safety assurance only on these courses.

Please turn over!

Ongoing forestry work has left much thinning and brashings on the ground in some blocks. Some paths and tracks have been damaged by heavy machinery, and new (unmapped) extraction paths may be encountered in some areas. In the thinned areas where brashings may impede progress the hatched green undergrowth has been broken to indicate the direction in which it is more easily crossed. New clear felled areas are mapped as rough open and are mostly slow, but with some unmapped extraction paths.

Undergrowth is generally not a serious impediment to progress, and courses have been planned to avoid the worst areas of brambles. Thickets have not been comprehensively re-mapped; some are shape-changed, newly grown or mown out. Fitness apparatus in the Arboretum area is not mapped.

Lynford is a public access forest area used by walkers, horse riders and cyclists amongst others. Please respect other forest users.

Full leg cover is compulsory. Ticks are common in Thetford Forest. Competitors are strongly advised to check themselves, their children and pet dogs for after the event.

Although you may encounter dogs on your course, please keep your own on a lead at all times including in the car park and registration areas.

To assist in the prevention of transmitting pests and diseases will you please thoroughly clean your orienteering kit and shoes when you leave the event, thank you.

You are advised to carry a whistle for emergency use only (six short blasts at minute intervals).

There are no drinks at the finish please bring your own.

Courses times, starts 10:15am to 12:15pm all courses close at 14:15hrs. You must report to the Download tent near registration by 14:15. Please immediately report to the download tent if you are still out on your course at this time.

Facilities: PortaLoo in corner of assembly/carpark. Car keys may be left at Registration upto 12:00, the box will then be transferred to Download tent.

First Aid: A first aid box is available at the Down load tent with list of club First Aiders.
