Sunday 27th June 2021 – Whitlingham Country Park, Norwich

Directions: Whitlingham Country Park is south of Norwich City centre. As you enter the village of Trowse from the

County Hall, turn left. This is signposted, and follow O signs to car parks. Map Ref TG 254 079.

Parking: Main visitor Car Parks. There is a parking fee of £2.80 for 2 hours, £4.00 for 3 hours, £5.00 for 4 hours or £6.00

all day. At the moment, some of the machines are card only.

Registration Open from 09.45 to 11.30 (*Red Shelter*).

& Enquires: Registration, Start and Finish is grouped together, 100m on the right along the road, from the barn.

Fees: Adults; £5.00; Juniors; £2.00; SI card (dibber) Hire 50p. (£30.00 if Lost).

To comply with BOF Covid rules, please bring correct money in an envelope if possible.

Course Details: There are two courses on offer. A One Hour Score event, with 30 + 2 controls to find. The second

course is a Yellow course, approx. 1.9km with14 controls.

Start & Finish: Starts from 1000hrs up to 1130hrs. Courses close at 1230hrs.

The start and finish are adjacent to the registration area.

Please DOWNLOAD when you finish (even if you have not completed your course; our safety check).

SI Sport-Ident Electronic punching.

AGM: Norfolk Orienteering Club is holding their AGM after this event. This will begin at 1300hrs, around the

registration area. Please bring a chair each, and a picnic if you wish. All NOR members most

welcome.

Map: The map of Whitlingham Country Park was first drawn in 2007. It has been updated regularly since.

Scale 1:7,500.

Safety notes: There is a minor road running through the middle of the map, which courses cross, so be careful of

traffic. Whitlingham Broad and the river is a key feature of the map. Please keep away from the water.

A first aid kit is available in the *Red* Registration Shelter, and in the tea room.

Facilities: There are temporary toilets in the barn car park and a café in the park. There is a Farmers Day being

held on this day, so do have a look at the tractors and farming machinery, where there will be

demonstrations and competitions. Food stalls will also be available.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed in the country park, but please keep them on a lead and under control.
