- Registration is adjacent to the car park. The start is approximately 600m from registration. Download is beside registration and is 50m from the finish.

Terrain:

This is a popular National Trust area, not used for orienteering since 2018. The map has been significantly updated for this event.

All courses will use predominantly the wooded area to the north of Felbrigg Hall, although the longer courses will also visit the pastureland to the south. The northwest part of the wooded area includes a series of pronounced spurs and re-entrants. The rest of the area has less contour detail and consists of mixed woodland of variable runnability.

Forestry work and heavy bracken growth in the northwest part have made runnability in some areas slow; however there is a good network of tracks and paths. Forestry extraction lanes have not been mapped.

Most courses (Orange and above) will run through fenced enclosures which are marked on the map as 'uncrossable'. Only crossing points marked on the map should be used.

Safety Information:

A risk assessment has been carried out by the organiser. Please note the following points when entering the event, and please refer also to the final details when published for any additional safety information.

- Participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event. By entering the event you are accepting this condition.
