**Directions:** signposted from A148 between Holt and Bodham. Look for brown tourist sign "Kelling Heath". Postcode: NR25 7HW. Grid Ref: TG118414. What3words: trend.crank.coffee.

Follow road round to the left to the Holiday Park centre, then park as directed.

**Newcomers:** are welcome, please come to the Red tent (Registration) before 11:45 and ask for advice.

**Online Entries** now closed; please contact the Organiser at <a href="Mornews@norfolkoc.co.uk">Nornews@norfolkoc.co.uk</a> for last minute entries.

**Entry on the Day:** limited, subject to map availability. You will need to complete a yellow registration form in block capitals with your details and the course you wish to enter before going to register. Families & Groups: please enter all names on the back of the form, and indicate if senior / junior (U21).

**Registration:** 10:00 - 12:00; **Starts** 10:15 - 12:15 (Courses Close at 14:15)

**Fees** Juniors / Students / Helpers - £3.00; Seniors / Families / Groups - £10.00. Senior BOF Members receive a £2 discount. E-card hire £1 (£30 charged if not returned).

**SIAC:** SIAC (contact-less punching) will be enabled on all controls EXCEPT Start, Finish, Clear and Check. Please remember to dib at the **Start** and at the **Finish**.

**Facilities:** Toilets in "Health and Fitness" building in "village square". Brackens café will be open serving soup and paninis, and hot drinks. Village Store and bar will also be open. Restaurant will be serving food from midday (booking recommended).

**Camping/Caravanning:** Kelling Heath Holiday Park is offering a special rate of **£20 per night** over the weekend of 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> December (excluding extras). Please book ASAP to ensure availability.

Dogs: on lead only and under control.

**Map Scale:** - All courses on 1:10000 scale maps with 5 metre contours, A4 size. White and Yellow maps will be available at Registration.

**Control Descriptions:** White and Yellow course maps have text and symbol descriptions printed on the front of the map. All other courses use standard IOF pictorial descriptions which will be on the front of the map. Separate control descriptions will be available in the Start lanes.

**Safety:** Please be aware there may be traffic on the holiday park roads, including near the Start kite. **White** and **Yellow** courses have a control at the Halt (railway platform) – take care as there is no fence. Both these sites will have marshals.

Please take care near ponds and on steep slopes. Full leg cover is compulsory.

**Other users:** the area is popular with walkers and dog walkers, as well as site users. Please respect other users. Please do not cross pitches unless completely empty and unfenced.

**Terrain:** Kelling Heath lies on the Cromer Ridge, a glacial moraine formed by retreating glaciers at the end of the last Ice age. It provides perhaps the best example of a glacial outwash plain in England with steep ice-contact slopes dissected by deep dry valleys. (abbreviated from Wikipedia)

The holiday park is on a relatively level area with a good path network, while the wooded north-facing slopes lead down towards the North Norfolk Railway line. Look out/listen out for the steam train passing! (Safely of course!)
