

Norfolk Orienteering Club Thetford Urban Saturday 20 April 2024 FINAL DETAILS (18.04.24)

Event Centre is at the Riversdale Centre, Tanner Street, Thetford, IP24 2BQ. (What3Words: ///enveloped.certainly.dolls) There is no parking at the Event Centre.

Toilets, bag drop, download, refreshments and cake will all be at the Event Centre. There are also a number of establishments in town for food and drink.

Event Car Parking / Transport – If arriving by car, please use the public car parking available in Thetford – most are free. Do NOT use the car park at Thetford Priory (nor visit the Priory before your run). We would suggest that anyone who is planning to Parkrun before the event use the car parking suggested for that, but subject to any restrictions that apply. Please note that we are aware of other people-heavy events taking place in town that day so parking closer to the Event Centre may be difficult – be prepared to park further away and walk in.

Please also consider using public transport. Thetford has a good train service, with 2 trains an hour from Norwich. The train station is 0.9km from the Event Centre.

Registration / Start times

Courses (final)

All courses go through an underpass twice (under the A134). Please do not cross the A134 other than via this underpass. The underpass is marked as a mandatory crossing on the course descriptions. In addition courses 1-3 all have a timed-out crossing of 90 seconds at a Pelican crossing of Norwich Road, as well as a second compulsory crossing via an underpass. These are also clearly marked on the course descriptions

The Start is located 0.6 km from the Event Centre, walking beside the River Little Ouse. <u>The</u> route from the Event Centre to the Start will be taped. There will be NO Bag Drop at the Start. <u>Control descriptions will be available at the Start.</u>

The finish is located close to Thetford Priory, 0.8 km from the Event Centre. <u>The route from the Finish to Download at the Event Centre will be taped.</u>

Event entry

Online entry has now closed. There will be limited Entry on the Day.

If you are not taking part in UKUL/SEOUL/EAUL, select "Open" for class. If you want your run to count as part of UKUL/SEUOL/EAUL, select a valid course / class combination, e.g. Course 3 / WV.

If you want your run to count as part of UKUL/SEOUL/EAUL in a higher class than your age, i.e. "run up", select the class associated with the course. For example a 60 year old male running Course 2 would select "MV" for class.

If you want to run a course shorter than your UKUL/SEOUL/EAUL age category, select "Open" for class, e.g. a 50 year old female wishing to run Course 4 would select "Open" for class

Courses 6 and 7 are available at the reduced rate to individuals and groups without orienteering experience, you should select "Novice" as class to enter these. Other courses are available to be entered by individuals without orienteering experience, at the higher fee rate, and you should select "Open" for these courses.

Groups should enter naming one/two individuals and whether further maps are required. Details of other individuals can be given at registration.

Juniors under 16 on 20 April may only enter on Courses 6 or 7.

Area

A fantastic new area for urban orienteering including estates to the north and south of Abbey Meadows, as well as the town centre for the longer courses. The terrain includes a variety of different types of housing estate, offering technical challenges through numerous alleys, similar layouts and lots of route choice options, as well as the Meadows and an exciting opportunity for all to orienteer on the site of a Medieval Priory! Note the Abbey Meadows and Thetford Priory may be wet.

<u>Do not visit Thetford Priory before you run your course.</u> Although most walls in the Priory are shown as uncrossable, please DO NOT clamber over any walls.

Safety

- There is one road crossing from the Event Centre to the Start, this will be marshalled, and then on to paved footpath along the River Little Ouse. We recommend that juniors are accompanied to the Start.
- The junior courses are based partly in a low traffic housing estate.
- All courses use one underpass under the A134, and for courses 1-3 there is an additional underpass on their course. USE OF THE UNDERPASSES IS COMPULSORY.
- There is one timed out road crossing on courses 1 to 3.
- Wide paths are for cyclists as well as pedestrians; be aware they can approach quickly and quietly.
- Be aware that some surfaces may be slippery when wet.
- All senior courses cross reasonably busy roads. It is your responsibility to cross them carefully, giving way to all vehicles and cyclists
- Please be courteous to pedestrians and take care when crossing the footbridge over the river, around buildings, and passing through gateways. <u>In particular the gateway</u> <u>into Thetford Priory is relatively narrow, please adjust your speed if there are</u> <u>pedestrians attempting to pass through at the same time.</u>

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General

You must not cross / run through any "uncrossable" objects. This is mandatory (not advisory).
